Promoting TVET in Secondary Schools November 2016 Outreach

During the month of November the National Training Agency (NTA) participated in several Career Fairs and Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) Promotions across the country. The School Visits focused on Career Development and Guidance for students of Forms 3, 5 and 6. Students were able to gain career guidance and advice, and obtain information about the Caribbean Vocational Qualification (CVQ), and expanded knowledge of TVET. The NTA team shared information on the careers and jobs in several sectors including, food and beverage, hospitality and tourism, financial, information and communication technology, agriculture and many others.

Also, during the later part of the month the team attended a Youth Empowerment Symposium, hosted by the Rotarac Club of Arima at the University of Trinidad and Tobago (UTT) campus in O'Meara. This was part of the club's goal to create a

foundation for sustainable community life. At the event, NTA staff was able to interact with students from the Arima North and Malabar Secondary Schools, and with other persons ages 18-30. Institutions in attendance included the College of Science, Technology and Applied Arts of Trinidad and Tobago (COSTAATT), the University of the Southern Caribbean (USC), Your Life Purpose Limited, the Water and Sewerage Authority (WASA), Republic Bank Limited (RBL), the University of Trinidad and Tobago, the Interagency Task Force, the Trinidad and Tobago Defence Force (TTDF), Arts in Action, the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service (TTPS) and AMGECU Credit Union.

Events like these are geared towards fostering intelligent and informed decisions about future vocational choices, and promoting Technical and Vocational Education and Training while assisting in the national effort of youth development.
